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Hard-to-read fonts aid recall of information, say researchers

Students across the ability spectrum demonstrate a significant improvement in retention and recall when presented with information in a 'harder to read' font, according to research conducted by teachers at Clifton College, an independent school in Bristol.

The researchers, led by physics teacher Matthew French, showed a Powerpoint slide to 275 students aged 13 to 16, in their normal mixed gender science classes which were set by ability. The slide contained information 56 words in length about a fictional white dwarf star. The students then continued with an unrelated lesson, before being given an unexpected multi-choice test on the information they had read about the star. The study group had the information presented in the harder-to-read, disfluent *Monotype Corsiva* font while a control group read a slide presented in the easy-to-read Arial

font. The two groups were balanced for ability.

The study group that had read the information in the harder-to-read *Monotype Corsiva* font scored 12.8 per cent higher in the test than the control group that had seen the information in the easy-to-read Arial font.

Students diagnosed as dyslexic showed an even greater than average difference in recall between the two groups (19 per cent).

The Clifton College Researchers say that harder-to-read fonts show promise in promoting recall and retention of written information. But they point out that their study used a brief passage and tested recall 30 minutes later. Further research is needed, they say, into whether the effect is the same for longer passages, recall over a longer time interval, and for questions that rely on more synthesis of information.

The result for dyslexic students, the researchers say, raises important questions for future research into the effect on dyslexic students of providing information in a harder-to-read font over a sustained period. Current educational orthodoxy is that dyslexic students should have information presented to them in an easy-to-read font.

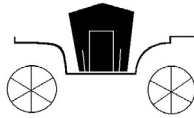

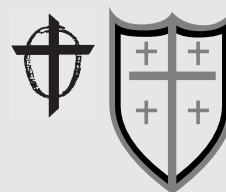
